Colin presents the enthralling story of the high-speed Schneider Trophy Air Races held between 1913 and 1931 at locations across Europe and US, including twice over the Solent from the Royal Air Force seaplane station at Calshot in the New Forest.

A British developer of these air racer seaplanes, Supermarine Aviation Works in Southampton, used their experience to develop the Spitfire WWII fighter aircraft.
